Player Code of Conduct

Etobicoke Football Club expects all players to comply and demonstrate high performance behaviors on/off the field as this will help support the growth of each member in our club. Mutual respect for all participants is the starting point towards positive contributions to our club culture. We must protect our culture and hold ourselves and teammates accountable to the code of conduct. This document is to serve as a guide and is principle based to assist players with making helpful/effective decisions on and off the field.

Respect

- Demonstrate mutual respect to all participants involved in Etobicoke FC and the same respect to external
 opposition
- Live the principles of fair play and keep a positive attitude and respect for all stakeholders regardless of the match result
- Always use language that is positive, helpful and supportive of all participants. Our club has zero
 tolerance for the use of abusive/foul language, profanity, inappropriate gestures, bullying and sexual or
 racial comments. It is the role of all players to not allow these unhelpful behaviors from occurring and if
 you see or hear any of the above, it is your responsibility as a player to stop the behavior immediately and
 report back to your team staff
- Respect for Match Officials and Opponents is expected at all times
- Wear the Etobicoke FC apparel and badge with honor, pride and represent our club values respectfully in all situations
- Respect all Covid-19 and Safety related protocols to ensure you are safe-guarding yourself and others in a responsible manner

Commitment

- All players are expected to attend all practices, games and team related activities unless a valid reason is provided to the Team Staff (Ideally 24 Hours prior)
- Arrive early prior to sessions and games to allow effective time to properly prepare yourself physically, mentally and technically/tactically for the task ahead
- Consistently demonstrate a deliberate and intense focus during training session and matches
- Fully embrace your team and individual goals, targets and objectives



Integrity & Attitude

- Bring actions to your words Do what you say you will do or at least make the right effort and have the right intentions to reach that objective/task
- Do what is ethically and morally correct at all times and situations
- Good mood equals good work. Have a high self-awareness to identify when your mood isn't at the optimal level and take the necessary actions to shift your attitude back in line with the high-performance mindset
- Be responsible for cleaning and taking care of your personal player equipment and apparel. Look and bring a professional approach to all sessions and matches
- Maintain self-control of emotions and have a calm mind to cope with adversity in a proactive and solution focused manner
- Role model the way that you want others to treat you Do onto others like you want others to treat you

Responsibility

- Each member of your team is responsible for living the club culture and enhancing it on a daily basis
- Take full responsibility of your own actions on/off the field and be honest/truthful regarding your personal actions and behaviors

Parent Code of Conduct

We all know that children's sports are supposed to be fun for the children involved. Unfortunately, there are some parents, fans and others that don't realize that their behaviours can have a lasting effect on children. Young athletes can be disillusioned in youth sports programs because adults have taken the fun out of the game. That is why we have put together the following **CODE OF CONDUCT** for parents and spectators to abide by during every Etobicoke Football Club team event. Please read and sign below to acknowledge your support of this policy.

I/We agree that:

- I/We will enjoy my child's opportunity to experience the benefits in participating in soccer.
- I /We will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, and not adults.
- I/We will inform the coach of any physical disability of ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- I/We will encourage my child and the other children on the team.
- I/We will make every effort to attend and be on time for all team events. If I am not in attendance of the event, I will make every effort to promptly pick up my child or make arrangements for their safe return to home.
- I/We (and my guests) will refrain from coaching my child or other players from the sidelines during games or practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
- I/We (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or event.
- I/We (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct toward any official, coach, player or parent. These include, but are not limited to: booing, taunting, use of profane language or gestures, or physical conduct.
- I/We will encourage my child to learn and play by the rules of the game and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility, violence or other behaviours that could endanger the health or well- being of other players.
- I/We will see that my child treats other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of their race, colour, creed, sex or ability.
- I/We will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.



- I/We will respect the coaches and officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss or confront coaches or officials at the game field, and will take the time to speak with coaches or officials at an agreed upon time and place.
- I/We understand that if I (or my guest) breach this code of conduct, my (our) privilege to attend games and practices could be revoked by the Club
- I/We understand that if the privilege to attend games or practices is revoked, any breach will result in the associated player's removal without compensation or refund.

Year-round Programming (November thru October); Breaks on statutory holidays; Winter Break (Holidays) Except If Festival Scheduled Indoor games will be played on turf fields. Outdoor games will be played on grass or turf fields.

Outdoor Training/Games

May 2023 to October 2023; One (1) Outdoor game per week on Grass (TOSL) Three (3) 90 minute sessions per week on Grass. *Training locations/surface types may change.
