RULE OF TWO POLICY

DEFINITIONS

<u>Vulnerable Person</u>: means any person under the age of 18 and any adult with a physical and/or mental impairment which impedes their ability to express or act on their wishes or to ascertain or exercise their rights.

Athlete: for purposes of this Policy means any Vulnerable Person participating in a Etobicoke Football Club program.

POLICY: PURPOSE

A Rule of Two Policy is designed to set standards for best practice to ensure the safety of Athletes participating in any Etobicoke Football Club activities.

PROCEDURE: RULE OF TWO

- 1. Employees, coaches, volunteers and contractors of the Etobicoke Football Club should never be alone (out of sight) with an Athlete.
- 2. All interactions between an employee, coach, volunteer or contractor and an Athlete must take place within ear shot or within view of a parent, guardian, or second employee, coach or volunteer except for medical emergencies.
- 3. Should there be a circumstance where a second employee, coach, volunteer or contractor is not available, then a parent or guardian of an Athlete on the same team may be recruited to fulfill the above obligations.
- 4. For purposes of number 3, above, one of the employees, coaches, volunteers, contractors, parents or guardians shall be of the same sex as the Athlete.
